17. **HIGHWAYS:**

i. **Matters reported/to be reported to DCC highways maintenance department:**

Potholes: Most of the many potholes reported had been filled, although some still remained.

Bus shelter: No further word about the barrier. This to be followed up. Litter in the shelter had been cleared, but more had appeared.

ii. **Public toilet:** A. Norman had received a request for the Council to consider the need for a public toilet in the village. The toilets at both the Tors and the village hall are used by 'non-customers', which adds to the cleaning costs at both. After discussion of this problem, the Council considered that even if grants were available for construction, there was no longer any funding from West Devon Borough Council or from the National Park, and so maintenance and cleaning would have to be an expense added to the precept. A site would also have to be negotiated with the Commoners. It was therefore decided not to follow up this idea at present.

iii. **Parking congestion:** The car park cannot be enlarged any further, and the congestion at weekends in the holiday season is getting worse. One car known to belong to a resident of another village is parked permanently at the top of the village. A note to be left for its owner.
